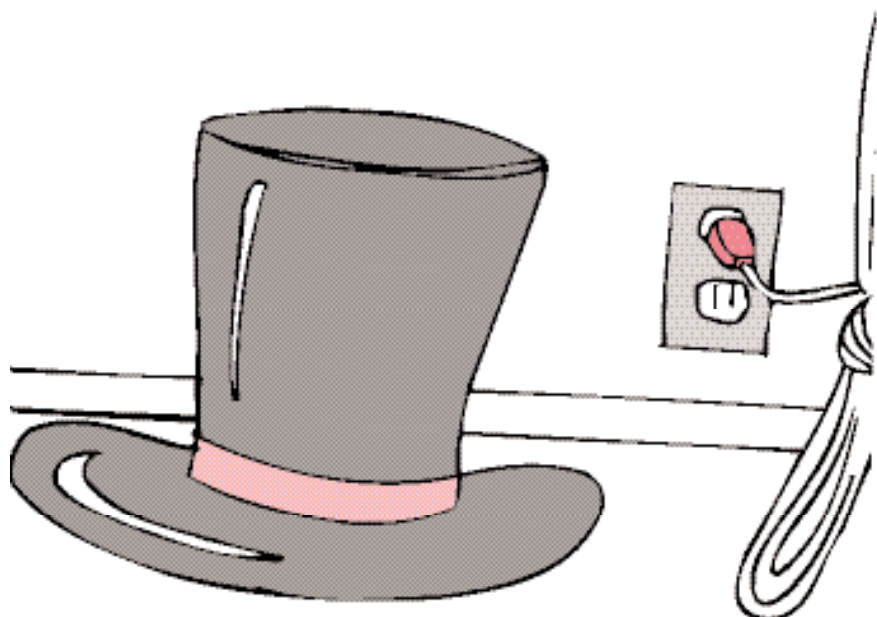

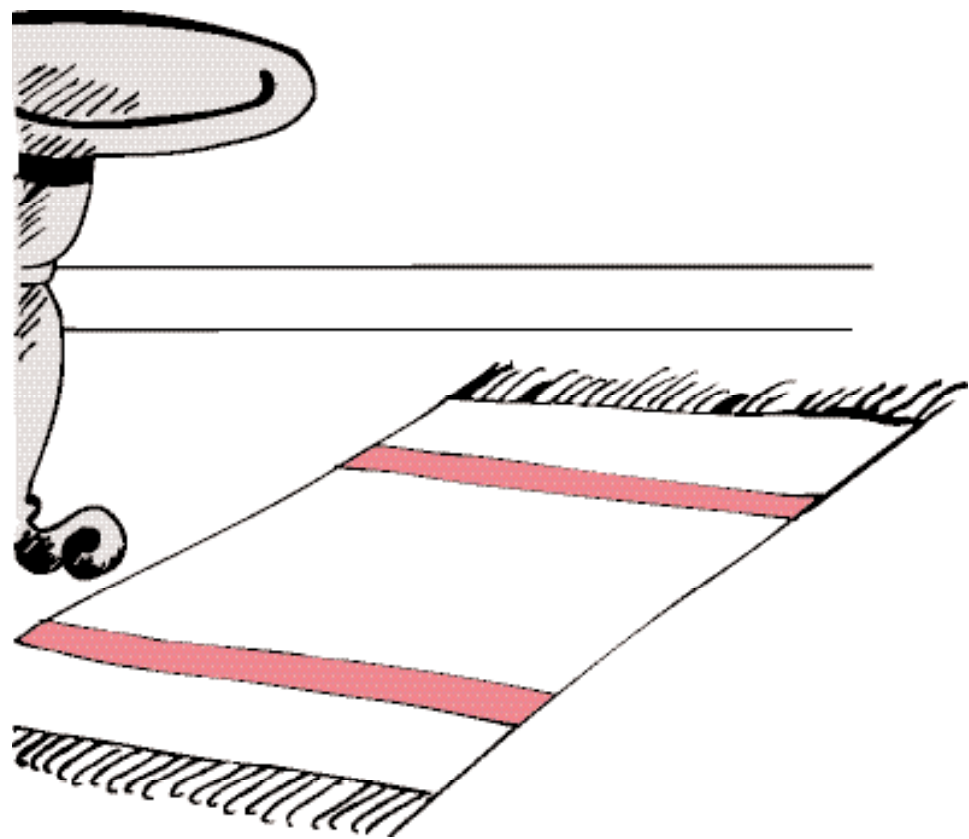

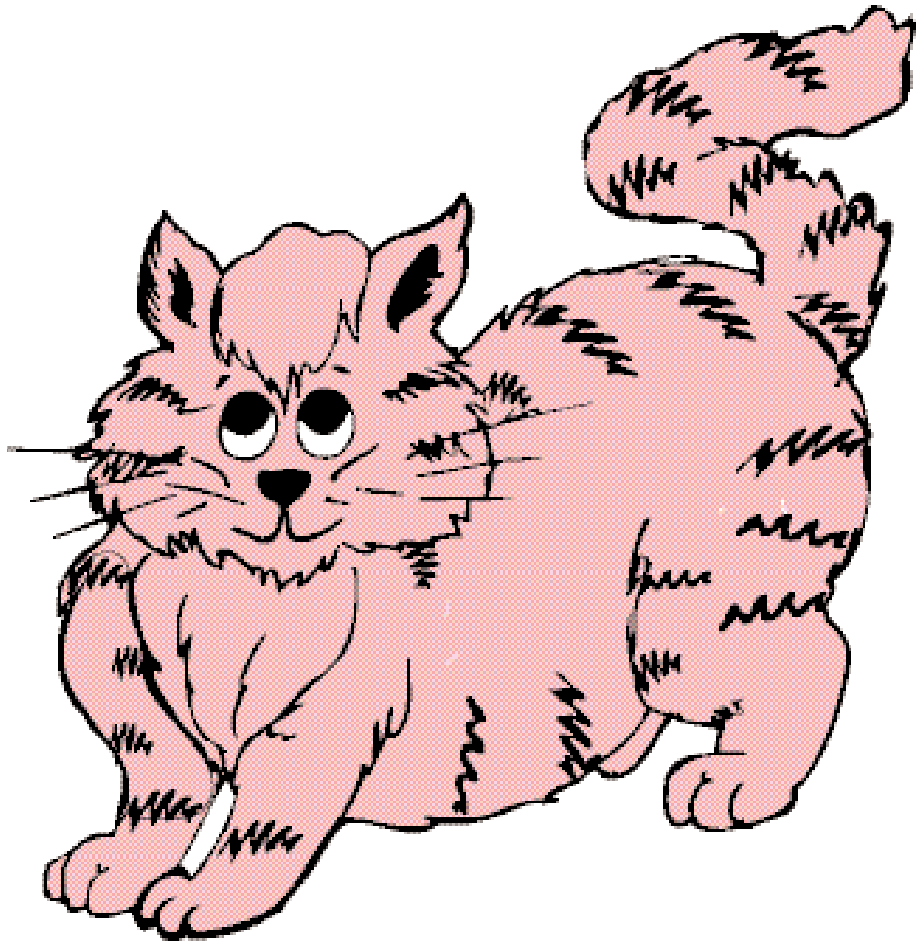

Suggestions for Checking Comprehension Skills

Set 1 Book 1

Level 1: Knowledge of Details, Facts and Information
(Who did it? What did they do? Where?)

Sample Question:
What is the name of the boy in this book?

Level 2: Understanding Facts and Information
(What happened first? Next? Last? When?)

Level 3: Application of Information to Solve Problems and Predict Outcomes
(How would you have prevented that from happening? What do you think will happen?)

Level 4: Analyze the Information
(How are ___ and ___ alike? What was the smallest...?)

Level 5: Using Information to Create New Ideas
(How would the story change if...? If you wrote a new ending for the story, what would it be like?)

Level 6: Drawing Conclusions and Judging Ideas
(Was that a wise thing to do? Why or Why not?)
